While attending school in Zürich, Switzerland, a 15-year-old Campion A. Platt decided to get his career path in order. He aimed to “focus and combine all of my talents into one profession, but it had to be a profession that would also allow me a broad education and include all the arts.” And it has. His comfortably modern interiors—often filled with furnishings of his own design—have been commissioned by celebrities and royalty, and by ideal clients who possess an “open vision, open attitude to change and a love for fine detail.” The architect, who is working on a new hotel in Boston and a ski-in/ski-out restaurant in Telluride, Colorado, stresses the “importance of the built world in our everyday life; from home to travel to office, our world is shaped by buildings and design.” However, if he had had to forgo the architecture degree from Columbia and pursue a different route, he might have studied to be “an astronomer or physicist,” he says, “with a minor in ice hockey.”
